


Classroom Expectations:

Independent Reading Project: Each of you will be required to read a novel of at least 200 pages during each semester of English 9. I have dozens of books that I am willing to check out to you or you can check our school's library. You will also need to complete a fairly large project associated with that novel, so get reading it ASAP! We will have reading time at the beginning of class at least once a week for roughly 10 minutes to allow you time to read in school. Whenever you finish an assignment early, you should immediately begin reading your novel. Therefore, there should rarely, if ever, be "down time" or "nothing to do." The sooner you complete the book, the sooner you can be done with the project!

Bathroom Passes: Bathroom passes will be up to my discretion. Typically, I do not like to be interrupted while I am in front of the class. We have relatively short class times here at Southwest so unless it is an emergency, please refrain



from asking to use the restroom. If you abuse this privilege in any way, do not expect me to write you future passes. Be honest. If you have to go, I get it, but please be as quickly as possible and of course, do not disrupt the rest of the class.

**Tardiness and Absences

Please be on time to class and prepared to learn. I know that passing time can be short and requires you to move swiftly but please make it a priority to make it to ALL of your classes on time!

2 tardies = warning

3 tardies = student call home to explain

4 tardies and every other after = a referral is written and potentially more penalties

Academic Dishonesty

I do not tolerate cheating or academic dishonesty of any kind. If I find out that any student is cheating in any way, the assignment will receive a zero and a phone call will be made home. I would much rather you be honest with me and say you didn't complete the assignment and need more time than simply copy someone else's work. This rule also applies to anyone who "helps" another student by allowing them to copy their own work. Don't do it.

Grading and Behavior: Please check your grade frequently to ensure you aren't missing any assignments. I am happy to sit down with you and discuss your grade, just schedule it with me beforehand. I work hard to grade without bias and to grade fair. On the other hand, I am extremely biased toward behavior. Do what you're supposed to in class and you will enjoy your experience. Behave poorly in class and your experience will be much less enjoyable.
